


Uniform carriageway

Strict lane driving for motorised vehicles along uniform lane widths for smooth traffic




- Cycle symbols for shared and dedicated stretches
- Cycle track painting in green colour for conflict zones
- Implemented Road safety devices
 - Cycle symbols 138 nos.
 - Thermoplastic paint 596 sq.m.
 - Cold paint for road marking 1721 sq.m.
 - Retro-reflective studs 250 nos.
 - Retro-reflective safety cones with chain 96 nos.
 - Spring bollards with cycle signage 51 nos.






- Retro-reflective, flexible spring posts

- Speed calming marking on all approaching roads to slow speeds of motorised vehicles and make it safe for the cyclists




