Guidelines for Stage 1 Submission

Step 1: Go through the submission checklist

Submission deliverables

- 1. 3 presentations* (30 slides each)
- **2. Video*** (1-2 mins)
- 3. Photos* (Maximum 10)
- 4. Additional documents (Maximum 5)
- 5. Project Description* (3 questions)
- 6. Cover letter*

* Submission Mandatory

Step 3: Fill the form and submit your city's entry!

- Use the official city email ID while submitting your entry.
- Google forms cannot be saved midway. We strongly recommend you keep all the submission deliverables ready, including the project description text.
- All files should be named with the format
 CITY NAME_DELIVERABLE
 (Example Malgudi_Image 1)
- Ensure that all the information is within the scope of the India Cycles4Change Challenge.
