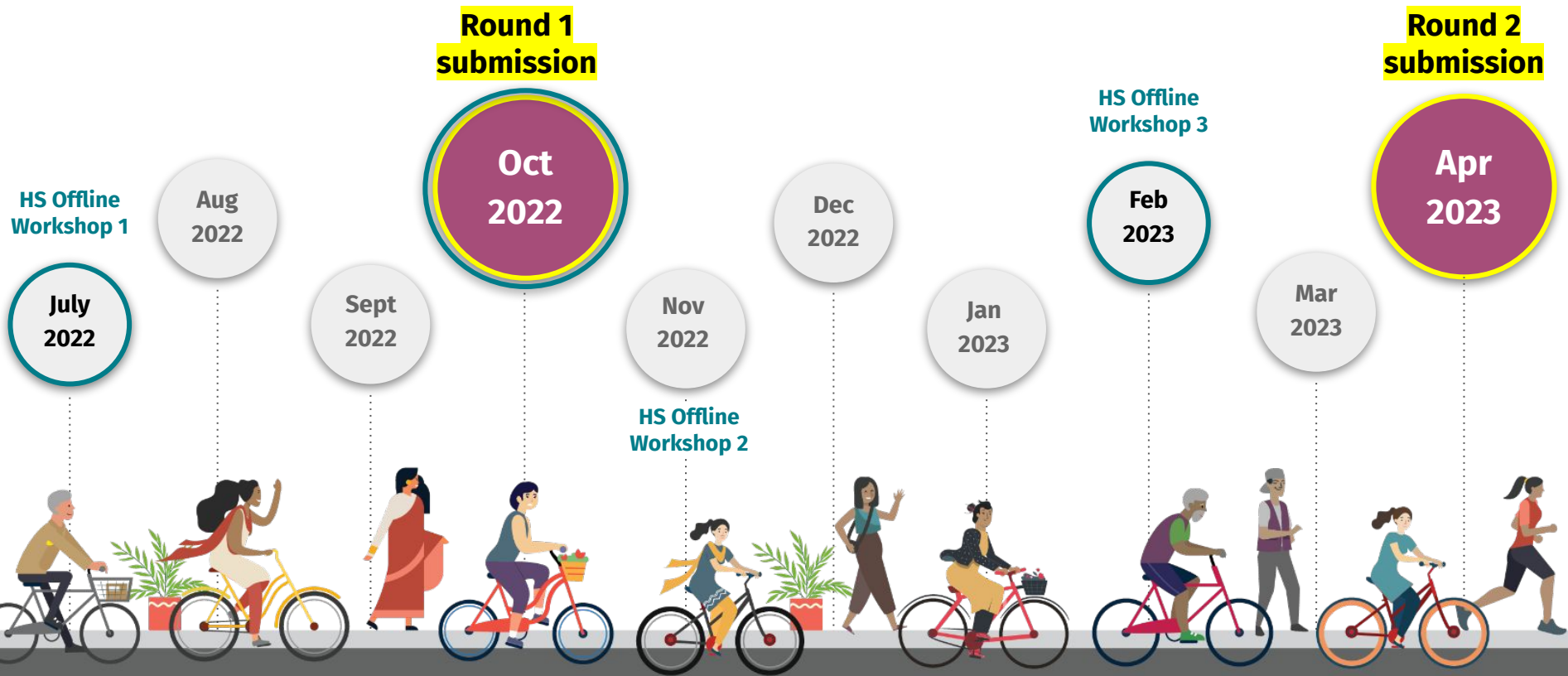

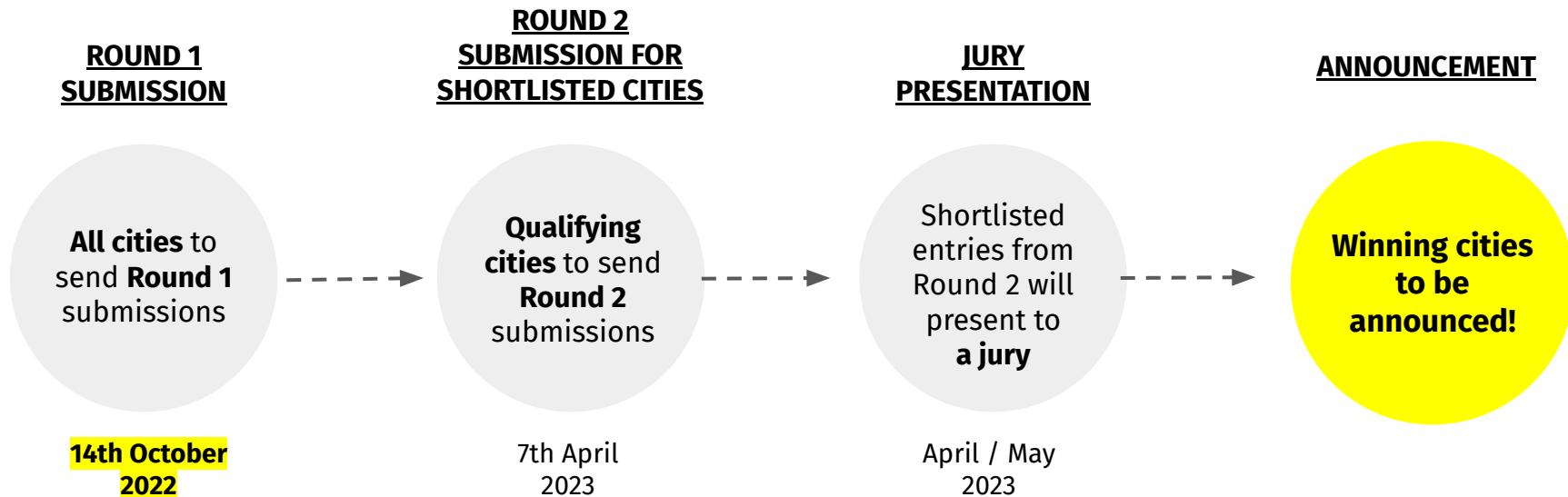

Stage 2 : Progress submission requirements: **October 2022**



Action

1. **Detailed design prepared for at least 10 km** of Healthy Streets network which could include - dedicated footpaths, protected cycle tracks, and safe intersections **and/or** traffic-calmed street network with segregated footpath and cycling made safe in mixed traffic.
2. Tested design through temporary trials and initiated permanent implementation for **at least 5 km of Healthy Streets** network (*only projects tendered out after June 2021 will be considered*)
3. **Launched other initiatives: Cycle training centers, Cycle repair clinics, Public Bicycle Sharing, etc.***



Foundation

1. Set up [Healthy Streets Apex Committee](#) and conducted regular meetings
2. Received sanction for setting up [Healthy Streets Cell / Department](#) under the Urban Local Body (ULB)
3. Adopted [Healthy Streets Policy](#)
4. Initiated creation of **walking and cycling Network Plan** for scaling up (for neighborhoods or city-wide)

Season 2 : Progress submission requirements: **October 2022**



Action

1. **Detailed design for at least 5 km** of Healthy Streets network with dedicated footpaths, protected cycle tracks, and safe intersections and/or traffic-calmed street network with segregated footpath and cycling made safe in mixed traffic
2. Tested design through temporary trials and initiated permanent implementation for **at least 3 km of Healthy Streets** network (*only projects tendered out after June 2021 will be considered*)
3. Launched other initiatives: Cycle training centers, Cycle repair clinics, Public Bicycle Sharing, etc.*

Pointers to note while filling up the Google Form

1. Go over the questionnaire and **keep your answers and documents handy** as you fill out the Submission form.
2. For the questions that require cities to **enter KM of infrastructure**, consider the infrastructure on either side of the street **separately**. *Examples provided in the questionnaire document.*
3. For the images upload, ensure the images are of **high resolution and quality**.
4. Ensure the information provided is in **alignment with the timeline** mentioned in the question.
5. Documents to be uploaded are documents that may already be available with your city. **The submission does not require cities to create new documents, unless necessary.**

Submission forms for Stage 2 and Season 2 cities will be separate

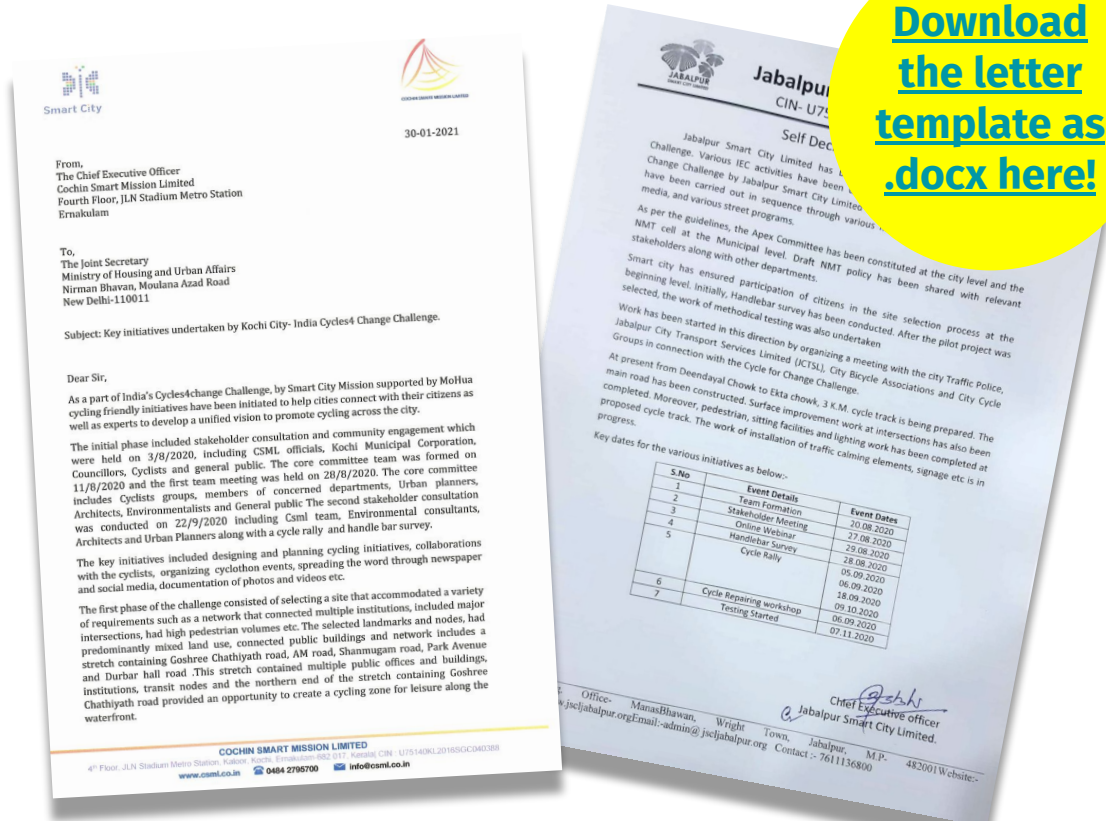

Pointers to note while filling up Section 5 in the Google Form

Section 5-Declarations includes a **mandatory** submission letter that must be signed by the **City Commissioner/ Smart city CEO, attesting to the accuracy of the information submitted in the form.**

1. Use the questionnaire and the Declaration letter to fill out the answers as you submit it for approval.
2. Get an approval on the information by the CEO / Commissioner through the Declaration Letter (template provided)
3. Fill in the approved information in the Google Form
4. Upload the signed and Sealed declaration letter in Section 5.

Kindly provide all the information requested in the letter. Feel free to add additional information.




Ensure that the letter is signed and uploaded only after the information is verified by the CEO / Commissioner

7. For how many KMs is the permanent implementation of **Healthy Streets infrastructure currently ongoing?***
(Projects tendered after June 2021)
Eg: If a 5km street stretch has footpaths being implemented on both sides and 5kms of Cycle Track on one side, enter the response as 10KM for footpaths and 5kms for cycle tracks and the Total as 15kms of Walking & Cycling Infrastructure.
8. Of this, how many KM of **dedicated footpaths** are currently being implemented?*
9. Of the total, how many KM of **segregated cycle tracks** are currently being implemented?*
10. How many KM are currently being **traffic calmed to 30kmph?***
11. How many **intersections** are currently being transformed to be safer?*

12. For how many KMs are permanent interventions of **Healthy Streets infrastructure completed?***
(Projects tendered after June 2021)
