



Stage 2: Progress submission requirements: October 2022











Action

- Detailed design prepared for at least 10 km of Healthy Streets network which could include - dedicated footpaths, protected cycle tracks, and safe intersections and/or traffic-calmed street network with segregated footpath and cycling made safe in mixed traffic.
- Tested design through temporary trials and initiated permanent implementation for at least 5 km of Healthy Streets network (only projects tendered out after June 2021 will be considered)
- 3. Launched other initiatives: Cycle training centers, Cycle repair clinics, Public Bicycle Sharing, etc.*

Foundation

- Set up <u>Healthy Streets Apex Committee</u> and conducted regular meetings
- Received sanction for setting up <u>Healthy</u> <u>Streets Cell / Department</u> under the Urban Local Body (ULB)
- 3. Adopted Healthy Streets Policy


The Google Form will be divided into 5 sections



Pointers to note while filling up the Google Form

- Go over the questionnaire and keep your answers and documents handy as you fill out the Submission form.
- For the questions that require cities to enter KM of infrastructure, consider the infrastructure on either side of the street separately. Examples provided in the questionnaire document.
- For the images upload, ensure the images are of high resolution and quality.
- Ensure the information provided is in alignment with the timeline mentioned in the question.
- Documents to be uploaded are documents that may already be available with your city. The submission does not require cities to create new documents, unless necessary.

Submission forms for Stage 2 and Season 2 cities will be separate




Pointers to note while filling up <u>Section 5</u> in the Google Form

Section 5-Declarations includes a mandatory submission letter that must be signed by the City Commissioner/ Smart city CEO, attesting to the accuracy of the information submitted in the form.


- Use the questionnaire and the Declaration letter to fill out the answers as you submit it for approval.
- Get an approval on the information by the CEO / Commissioner through the Declaration Letter (template provided)
- Fill in the approved information in the Google Form
- Upload the signed and Sealed declaration letter in Section 5.

Kindly provide all the information requested in the letter. Feel free to add additional information.



Ensure that the letter is signed and uploaded only after the information is verified by the CEO / Commissioner
