
<u>Census (2011)</u>

"A household member whose last usual place of residence (UPR), anytime in the past, was different from the present place of enumeration was considered as a migrant member in a household."







Data on Migrants is...

Outdated

- Last conclusive figures of internal migrants is derived from Census 2001. Complete migrant data from Census 2011 still to be released.
- Various data sources of migration in India include NSSO(2007-08) under MOSPI, Census(2011), Economic Survey of India (2017-18), Ministry of Finance. Each Ministry uses a different definition of 'Migrant'.

<u>Static</u>

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic that hit the entire world, the need for collection of data on migrants has gained mileage. This data has been captured by independent NGOs, District Labour Offices, Police Stations, NMIS portal by NDMA and state travel portal amongst others. The data collected however, remains static in nature.

<u>Incomplete</u>

- Despite the presence of various schemes and laws to provide benefits to migrants, these remain under-utilized giving misleading numbers for the migrant population.
- Circular migration is not captured
- Migrant Source state is captured in the Census data without capturing the district/city
- Worker description is defined as per tenure not as per occupation


