Streets are developed for **motorists** and not for pedestrians (all ages)





## **Issues**At H.P petrol pump, Mumbai

- 1. Large intersection area
- 2. No pedestrian markings
- 3. Inaccessible traffic islands
- 4. No median refuge for pedestrians














### **Proposed Design**
