Area of expertise:

- The climate parliament is an international cross-party network of legislators, dedicated to preventing climate change and promoting renewable energy.
- The climate parliament is structured in three parts: an international parliamentary network made up of over a hundred MPs and legislators from around the world; a secretariat of experts and researchers who provide staff support to the network and a board of trustees.

Support to programme:

- The climate parliament can provide advisory support to the ministry of urban development in tools, technology and resources required to create sufficient supply of renewable energy.
- The climate parliament has identified key areas for policy push that could get renewable energy to the point where it could out compete fossil fuels on price – without subsidies.
