## Award Process

The nominations to CSI-Nihilent e-Governance Awards are accepted through a transparent, e-submission mode with authorization by a responsible Government authority. All nominations are evaluated by panel of experts drawn from the Government, Industry and the Academia. The judging process, shared and communicated makes the evaluation exercise completely objective.

For 2015-16, the multi-stage assessment process involved review of Expression of Interest and detailed nomination forms submitted in prescribed format, field visit to shortlisted nominees to assess the degree to which the online submissions match the reality on the ground, and further, validation of findings by different set of committee members as part of the 'Finalists' presentations. Every stage of the assessment process went through a conscious effort to reduce individual bias and provide for checks and balances.
