What are we looking for?

The international competition "beyond bauhaus – prototyping the future" honours twenty groundbreaking design concepts which address relevant social issues, in ways both big and small, and contribute to making the world a healthier, fairer, more sustainable and better place.

In particular, the competition will evaluate (1) design vision (2) sustainability and (3) potential social impact.

An independent, international jury selects the best projects.

Who can participate?

The competition is open to designers and creatives from across the world and from all design disciplines: from basic research and materials science to product design, fashion, architecture, urban development mobility and future technologies. The competition seeks both prototypes in the development stage and pioneering projects already being implemented. Applications are open to individuals, social entrepreneurs, companies, start-ups, universities and research institutions as well as private initiators and initiatives.

What can the award winners expect?

- Award winners will be communicated internationally during the official celebrations of the centennial anniversary of the Bauhaus.
- Winners will be invited to Berlin in August 2019, when their projects will be presented in an exhibition at the CLB Berlin at Aufbau Haus. Travel and accommodation costs will be paid by the organizer.
- An accompanying programme of events will provide opportunities to network with other prize-winners and Berlin's creative scene.

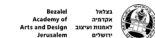
